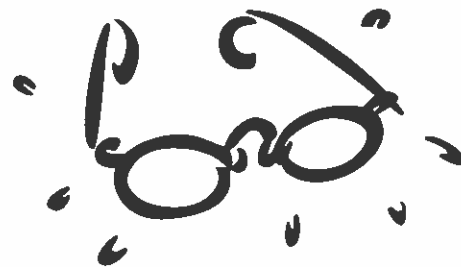


Understanding Expenses
