Empty and clean the food pantry.	Remove all furniture.
Empty and clean the cabinets.	Remove all lightbulbs.
Empty and clean the refrigerator (will be staying with property).	Clean the toilets.
Clean the stove-top and oven.	Clean the tub and shower.
Empty the trash.	Remove the blinds.
Sweep and mop the floor.	Vacuum the carpets.
Paint the walls.	Empty the closets.

Wash the walls.	Call the utility companies and ask to
Paint the walls and ceilings.	have service stopped or transferred.
Vacuum the carpets.	——— Place appliance manuals (stove, dishwasher, etc.) in an obvious place.
Remove picture hangers from walls.	Fill out change of address cards at the post office.
Patch holes in the walls.	
Remove cable wires from the walls.	Bleach the garage floor.
Remove wallpaper.	Call the newspaper and ask to have service stopped or transferred.
