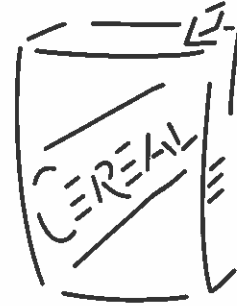


Dealing with Pest Control
