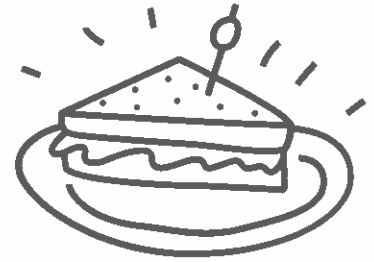


Being a Good Employee
