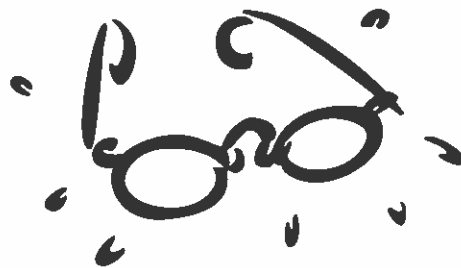


Understanding Expenses
